ARCHAEOLOGY CAMP July 9-13

Do you have a burgeoning Indiana Jones? Come learn the basics of archaeology, and learn through doing. Our location in the park is at the bottom of an old Ordovician Sea, and fossils abound here.



Activities include:

- Digs here at the village
- Learn about artifacts & interpretation
- Learn about terminology & application

PIONEER CAMP July 30-August 3

Learn what life was like for kids in 1800s Southwest Ohio. Campers visit our thirteen historical buildings to discover different aspects of pioneer life such as cooking, chores, games, medicine, and transportation.



Activities include:

- Hearth cooking
- Making butter
- Making cornhusk dolls
- Playing with pioneer toys
- Washing clothes on a washboard



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Campers must be six to twelve years of age (& completed kindergarten)
- Camp runs Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 3:30 pm. Friday 2:30-3:30, there will be a special presentation for parents
- Fees are: Members—\$150/week
Non-members—\$175/week
- Siblings registered for the same week receive a \$5 discount
- There is a “Come Early / Stay Late” option. Campers can be dropped off as early as 8:00 am and picked up as late as 5:30 pm, for a daily fee of \$15.00
- Days are planned with learning and recreational activities, as well as free time
- Campers bring a packed lunch each day and make their own snacks during the camp day
- Water is provided throughout the day
- Campers are in a safe environment and have adult supervision at all times
- **Payment is due with registration to hold your child’s place in camp**
